These repairs have been recommended as a priority by your local County Councillor Richard Roberts and are funded using the Highways Locality Budget.



 If you need to use your vehicle, please make sure you move it outside the road closure area shown on this letter, at least 30 minutes before we are due to start working

#### What you need to know:

- Vehicles will not be allowed access through the road closure during the works, except for emergency vehicles.
- Please refer to the yellow signboards on your street to see the exact dates, timings and permit number. - These works are weather dependent and may be postponed if poor weather is forecast.
