**Re: Tree Felling works in the Kings Langley electoral division commence
01/09/2026**

A program of tree safety works in your area will be commencing as of late August 2026. The works program includes a variety of tree maintenance operations to reduce tree related risks to users of the highway network, and to promote the longevity of highways trees.

Following an inspection of trees in your road, we have identified issues with the health of a tree near your property (in some locations the tree may have been marked with orange paint). On the advice of our Tree Specialist, a decision has been made to cut down (fell) the tree to remove the risk to people and nearby property. **Felling works will commence from 01/09/2026 in the Kings Langley Electoral Division.** Unfortunately we cannot provide an exact date for tree works outside individual properties.

What do we need you to do?

In most cases, our arboricultural contractors will aim to complete the work with as little impact to residents as possible. However, in some instances it may be necessary for residents to move cars or to comply with some traffic management. If this is the case, residents closest to the tree works may receive a notice requesting the area is kept clear of vehicles (cones and/or signs saying 'No Parking' will indicate the area to be left clear of vehicles) or may be contacted by our contractors directly to discuss any specific impacts the works may have to the immediate area. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your patience whilst we carry out these essential safety works.

Replanting

Felled street trees will be replaced. While most street trees can be replaced in their original location, this may not always be appropriate or safe. In these instances, we will aim to plant in a suitable nearby location. All tree planting is subject to resources in the Winter season 2026-27.
